h1819. דָּמָה *dâmâ*; a primitive root; to compare; by implication, to resemble, liken, consider: — compare, devise, (be) like(-n), mean, think, use similitudes.

AV (29) - like 14, liken 5, thought 6, compared 1, devised 1, meaneth 1, **similitudes 1**;

Hosea 12:10 (KJV) – I have also spoken by the prophets, and I have multiplied visions, and used **similitudes**, by the ministry of the prophets.
